Why does the job exist?

The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) is charged by law with regulating the rates and service of investor-owned public utilities (electric, gas, water, wastewater), telecommunications and motor carrier companies. This position will provide legal counsel to PRC Utility Division Staff comprised of economists, accountants and engineers, concerning the regulation of public utilities in adjudicatory and administrative proceedings before the Commission. This position may also provide counsel to the Commission and Chief of Staff concerning management issues, agency programs and operations.

How does it get done?

-Through the development of legal strategy and management of cases; research and analysis of local, state, and federal law as it applies to the proceeding; drafting of pleadings and legal briefs; and the presentation of oral argument, direct and cross examination of witnesses.

Who are the customers?

Agency staff, PRC Commissioners and members of the public.

Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate would possess five or more years of experience in administrative, government or public law; administrative hearings or trial practice; economics, accounting, engineering, mathematics or sciences, with subject-matter experts in a related technical or financial field; and interpreting and applying administrative rules and regulation

Minimum Qualification
