Manages and oversees day to day operations of General Counsel Division

**Minimum qualifications:** JD from an accredited law school; ten years of experience in the practice of law, including at least four years of administrative or regulatory law practice and three years of staff supervision; admission to the New Mexico Bar or commitment to taking and passing Bar Exam within six months of hire. Background in public utilities, telecommunications, transportation, engineering, economics, accounting, litigation, or appellate practice preferred.
