

NEW MEXICO PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSION

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PROCEDURE FOR POSTING TRANSCRIPTS

I. Purpose

The following sets out the procedures that will apply to receipt and distribution of transcripts prepared for all New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) public hearings by a court reporter. This procedure applies to all NMPRC hearings including cases where a party requests an expedited transcript and cases where transcripts are prepared on a non-expedited basis. This procedure will be posted on the NMPRC website homepage and prominently displayed in the Records Bureau.

II. Effective Date

July 25, 2018, until superseded.

III. Procedures

Consistent with Rule 1.2.2.34 NMAC, the following procedures will be implemented by the Records Bureau:

1. Transcripts will not be posted on the NMPRC's E-Docket system until after 15 calendar days from the date of the NMPRC's receipt of the transcript from the court reporter.
2. After the transcript is received by the NMPRC, the transcript is available for inspection in person at the NMPRC Records Bureau, 1120 Paseo De Peralta, Room #406, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87501.
3. During the 15 calendar days between the date the transcript has been received by the NMPRC from the court reporter and the date it is posted on E-Docket, a copy of the transcript is available upon direct request to the court reporter for a fee charged by the court reporter, or through an Inspection of Public Records Act (IPRA) request to the NMPRC, and the transcript will be provided, in accordance with procedures and fee schedule set forth in the NMPRC IPRA policy posted on the NMPRC website:<http://nmprc.state.nm.us/administrative-services/docs/INSPECTION%20OF%20PUBLIC%20RECORDS%20POLICY%20and%20ELECTRONIC%20MESSAGING.pdf>
