APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from JEMEZ MOUNTAINS ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions.

1. The Applicant will pay the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee.

2. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises below and will pay therefor monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the bylaws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished industrial users. The Applicant will pay a bill of at least \$.....per month regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed.

3. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by Cooperative. The Applicant's house is approximately.....feet from proposed distribution line andfeet from the nearest public road.

4. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the certificate of incorporation and bylaws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.

5. The Applicant, by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility of any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property cannot be attached for any such debts or liabilities.

6. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative, and the contract for electric service shall continue in force for one year from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant, and thereafter until cancelled by at least 3 days written notice given by either party to the other.

7. The undersigned agrees that the Cooperative shall have the right to construct reasonable facilities and to operate and maintain electric distribution facilities on his or her property.

In granting this privilege it is understood that at pole locations, only single pole and appurtenances will be such as to form the least interference to farm, or other operations of the consumer, so long as it does not materially increase the cost of construction.
