Scope of Operations

A taxicab service, non-emergency, transporting passengers and their baggage between points and places within Chaves, Eddy and Lea Counties in New Mexico on the one hand and on the other hand to points and places in New Mexico, over irregular routes under non-scheduled service.

A specialized passenger transportation service, of aged and disabled persons in wheelchair by vehicles especially modified therefore, between points within Chaves, Eddy and Lea Counties between points and places in New Mexico, over irregular routes under non-scheduled service.

Transportation of handicapped persons needing special equipment, wheelchairs, walkers, canes and needing assistance getting in and out of vehicles by means of a van service between points and places in NM, over irregular routes under non-scheduled service.

Equipment will be stationed at 2314 W. Main, Artesia, NM.

Usual hours of operation will be Monday through Friday, 8:00am through 5:00pm, except for the following listed holidays; New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas as per J&J Home Care, Inc.

Exception to these hours of operation, transportation may be scheduled 7 days a week, 24 hours a day and may operate 365 days per year according to arrangements and need.

SECTION I

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO PASSENGER SERVICE AND HANDIVAN SERVICE

ITEM

- 10 **APPLICATION OF TARIFF:**
Rates and provisions named in this tariff, or as amended, are limited to their application to extent of the operating rights set forth below.
- 20 **IRREGULAR ROUTES:**
All passengers may be transported over irregular routes under non-scheduled service.
- 30 **INTERRUPTION AND DELAY OF SERVICE:**
The carrier shall not be liable for any interruption or delay of service due to an accident, breakdown, bad condition of roads, snow storms, strikes or other conditions beyond its control. This tariff does not obligate carrier to transport passengers when weather or road conditions make it impractical or dangerous to operate. The carrier does not guarantee to arrive or depart from any point at a specific time.
- 40 **METHOD OF DETERMINING FARES:**
The fare will be either flat rate (within the city limits of Artesia) and any out of town transportation will be calculated on a per mile basis.
- 50 **CARRIER LIABILITY:**
The carrier will not be liable for a delay caused by accidents, breakdowns, bad condition of road, weather conditions or other conditions beyond its control and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specific time. Nothing in this tariff shall obligate the carrier to transport passengers when the weather or road conditions make it impractical or dangerous to operate.

SECTION I continued:

60 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS:

The carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs. The carrier also reserves the right to refuse transportation to any threatening, abusive or otherwise dangerous persons. The carrier reserves the right to have all vehicles smoke free.

70 PETS ACCEPTANCE OF:

Birds, dogs, cats or other pets in excess of one per trip will not be transported by the carrier if the animal is not properly housed or caged. It is the intent of this carrier to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. This item is not meant to exclude or in any way affect the use by any disabled persons of an attendant animal or person.
