TORRENCE, SANTA FE AND CIBOLA COUNTIES ON THE OTHER HAND.**

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PROPOSED SCOPE OF OPERATIONS

A Taxi Authority restricted as follows: The unscheduled transportation of passenger(s) by Other than a taxi service, Limousine Service, or Charter Service as defined by the Public Regulation Commission under its rules and regulations in effect February 15th 1993 and as modified November 30, 1995, can transport greater than seven (7) passengers, over irregular routes between the Albuquerque International Airport one the one hand and points and places in Bernalillo, Sandoval, Valencia, Torrence, Santa Fe, and Cibola Counties on the other hand.

SECTION I
GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS
PERTAINING TO PASSENGER TRANSPORTATION

- 10 **APPLICATION OF TARIFF**
Rates and provisions named in this tariff, or as amended are limited in their application to the extent of the operating rights granted.
- 20 **IRREGULAR ROUTES**
All passengers may be transported over irregular routes under non-scheduled service.
- 30 **GOVERNING PUBLICATION:**
This tariff makes reference to the recent issue of the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments transportation planning map and the Rand McNally Map.
- 40 **INTERRUPTION AND DELAY OF SERVICE**
The carrier shall not be liable for any interruption or delay of service due to accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, snow storms, strikes, riots, or other conditions beyond its control. This tariff does not obligate carrier to transport passengers when weather or road conditions make it impractical or dangerous to operate. The carrier does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time.
- 50 **METHOD OF DETERMINING RATES**
This transportation service determines its rates based on a grid zone system. A computer database locates the start point and end point of a trip. The database then determines the correct grid zone and applies the appropriate rate for that trip. This grid zone structure is depicted on the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments transportation planning map for visual reference.
- 60 **BAGGAGE LIABILITY**
Carrier will not be liable for loss of baggage or other passenger property. In the event of damage to personal property, the maximum liability of carrier shall be limited to \$50.00 per passenger.
- 70 **OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS**
The carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any individual who in the opinion of the driver threatens the safety and health of the other passengers.
- 80 **TAXES**
All applicable taxes and any fees charged by Federal, State or Local agencies will be added to the applicable fare.

RATES AND CHARGES FOR PASSENGERS

Note 3 These rates are based upon grid zones as shown on the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments transportation planning map of the Greater Albuquerque Metropolitan area plus certain neighboring communities, all in New Mexico, and the zones are identified by grid references which include an alphabetic character and an Arabic numeral taken from the Rand McNally map of the greater Albuquerque Metropolitan area to identify one mile squares on the map. The Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments transportation planning map is attached to this tariff and is included herein as the official guideline for the location of the grid zones.

Note 4 Round Trip tickets may be purchased for \$2.00 less than twice the applicable zone rate for one passenger.

Note 5 When one or more passengers (Companion Fare) is traveling on the same ticket from the same origin to the same destination at the same time on the same date, the first passenger's rate is the regular zone rate and each additional passenger is \$2.00 in Zones A & B, \$5.00 in Zone C, \$8.00 in Zones D, E, F, G, H, J, K, L, M, \$10.00 in Zones N,P,Q,R,S,T, and \$15.00 in Zones U, V, after the third passenger.

Note 6 Senior Citizens shall be entitled to a \$1.00 discount off their fare each way. This note will apply to any ADA eligible passenger.

Note 7 Animals / pets will be in approved cages or crates (not to include handicap assistance animals in performance of their duties). Airport Shuttle reserves the right to refuse transportation of any animal deemed unsafe or beyond the capability of Airport Shuttle to transport safely. This excludes any assistance or guide animal as defined by the ADA.

Note 8 Baggage in excess of 2 pieces per passenger, not to include personal handbags or briefcases, will be \$2.00 per additional piece. No piece shall be transported that may endanger the physical safety of the driver.

100 RECEIPTS.
 All passengers will be given an Airport Shuttle receipt for transport and no passengers will travel without a receipt unless prior billing arrangements have been made.

 Hotels, Bed and Breakfasts will be considered to be in the zones indicated.
