Commissioner Lovejoy Focusing On Solutions to AV Water Issues

SANTA FE – In her motion at the Wednesday, October 5 meeting of the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission, Commissioner Lynda Lovejoy included expanding the scope of the Commission’s September 14 order to AV Water Company LLC that set an expedited hearing on potential penalties and refunds by adding the feasibility of finding a new operator.

“We are at a point where we need to seek all options because simply depending on fining the company for violations is not a solution,” Commissioners Lovejoy stated. “The New Mexico Environment Department has already imposed fines for the company’s non-compliance. I am concerned that the company may not be financially sound and have the adequate staff to sustain future management and operation.”

Commissioner Lovejoy’s motion also included holding the next Commission meeting along with conducting the first of two hearings immediately following the conclusion of the Commission meeting in Aztec on Wednesday, October 12. The Commission agreed to Commissioner Lovejoy’s motion with a unanimous vote.

The hearing will be held at 9:30 a.m., at the San Juan County Administration building located at 100 Oliver Drive in Aztec, on Wednesday, October 12.
