PRC Chair Espinoza Completes Regulatory Studies Program

SANTA FE – New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) Chair Valerie Espinoza successfully completed a Michigan State University’s Institute of Public Utilities program earlier this month. Espinoza successfully completed the 58th Annual Regulatory Studies Program in East Lansing, Michigan, on August 12, 2016.

This essential program, which is endorsed by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, is referred to as “Camp NARUC” and is designed specifically and exclusively to meet the needs of public-sector regulatory professionals, particularly members of NARUC. With more than 1,000 years of experience, the Institute’s diverse program faculty is drawn from various academic, governmental, and other organizations. Presentations cover all aspects of the regulatory process, as applied generally and particularly to electricity, natural gas, water, and telecommunications sectors. Methods of instruction provide opportunities for exploration and interaction, and concurrent and bonus sessions allow participants to tailor the program to their particular needs and areas of interest and responsibility.

The Annual Regulatory Studies Program is grounded in sound regulatory theory and established practices.

The Camp program is designed specifically for personnel of local, state, and federal agencies involved in utility industry regulation. Participation is open only to individuals working for governmental and public-sector organizations.
