## **Commissioner Lovejoy Completes Electric Utility Regulation Coursework**

**SANTA FE** – New Mexico Public Regulation Commissioner Lynda Lovejoy completed one week of “Practical Regulatory Training for the Electric Industry,” sponsored by the Center for Public Utilities, New Mexico State University, May 16-20, 2016, at the Sheraton Inn-Uptown Albuquerque.

The overview of course included overall cost of service/revenue requirement; set up and start revenue requirements problems; total system and class-specific load characteristics; overview of class cost of service studies; rate design; renewable energy, distributed generation and net metering; and energy efficiency mandates.

“This training further enhances my knowledge and ability to absorb legal and technical details of the basic structure of electric utility regulation,” Commissioner Lovejoy stated.
