Commissioner Espinoza Issues Statement Following PRC's Decision to Grant PNM Additional Time

SANTA FE – On Wednesday, June 24, the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (PRC) voted 4-1 to grant additional time to Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) regarding agreements between the state's largest electric utility company and other entities pertaining to the San Juan Generating Station.

Commissioner Valerie Espinoza (District 3) issued the sole dissenting vote in this matter, and issued the following statement Wednesday afternoon.

“It is my hope that PNM will take the lead and rethink the proposed plan as recommended today, and work with the opposition to formulate a solution that will be a win-win for all customers. This will demonstrate a willingness to work with the interveners and the PRC.”
