A RESOLUTION TO SET COMMISSION REQUIREMENTS OF THE AMBULANCE ANNUAL SERVICE REPORT

***WHEREAS**, the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (“Commission”) has identified a need for additional information from certificated ambulance service motor carriers in its EMS Bureau Annual Service Report, that is prepared each year in accordance the Transportation Division’s Motor Carrier Rules, Ambulance, 18.3.14.22 NMAC; and*

***WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that, pursuant to Rule 18.3.14.22.F NMAC, the Commission has the authority to require additional information to be provided by certificated ambulance service motor carriers ; and*

***WHEREAS**, the Commission, after due consideration of input from the Transportation Division, has determined that it is the public interest and promotes administrative efficiency for certain additional information to be provided by each certificated ambulance service motor carriers in its EMS Bureau Annual Service Report for comprehensive compliance monitoring and regulatory oversight.*

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Commission shall immediately require the following information be included by each certificated ambulance service motor carrier in its EMS Bureau’s Annual Service Report, starting with the January 15, 2021 Annual Service Report for the preceding year:

- *Name of the Certificate Holder and the NMPRC number;*
- *Name of Lessee (if applicable);*

- *Mutual Aid Plans/Agreements per 18.3.14.9 NMAC;*
- *Counties authorized to operate in;*
- *Number of runs completed per county authorized to operate in 18.3.14.24 NMAC;*
- *Number of ambulance accidents to ensure compliance of 18.3.7.11 NMAC;*
- *Copy of the carrier's hours of service policy per 18.3.4.10 C NMAC;*
- *Random drug testing information per 18.3.4.10 NMAC; and*
- *Medical Director and Training Coordinator information per 18.3.14.11 NMAC*

In addition, all ambulance service providers are requested to report the number of times during the previous year that they have provided ambulance service outside of their certificated territory. Such information is intended to assist the Commission in its efforts to study the adequacy of ambulance service throughout the State.

The Commission's Transportation Division shall provide notice of this Resolution to all certificated ambulance service motor carriers at the address filed with the Transportation Division by email or, if no email, by USPS address.
