### **Dear Incidental Carrier:**

Your business has been identified as possibly being an Incidental Carrier as defined by the State of New Mexico, NMSA 1978, §65-2A-3. The Public Regulation Commission ("Commission" or "PRC") Transportation Division is advising that you must comply with the insurance requirements for incidental carriers, which requires that incidental carriers maintain a combined single limit public liability policy amount of a least Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) per occurrence.

### **The Motor Carrier Act State Statute is defined on Incidental Carrier as: ...**

S. "Incidental carrier" means a motor carrier of persons that transports passengers using vehicles designed to transport sixteen or more passengers, including the driver, and for which the customer pays either directly or indirectly.

### **New Mexico Public Regulation Commission Motor Transportation Rule 18.3.3.10 NMAC: MINIMUM LIMITS OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: ...**

G. Incidental carriers must maintain a combined single limit public liability policy amount of at least two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) per occurrence for bodily injury to or death of all persons injured or killed and property damage

In order to comply with the Minimum Limits of Public Liability you must submit the application enclosed along with Insurance Form-E, with-in ten (10) days of the date of this notice to avoid any further action. If you believe you are not an incidental carrier, please return the form with an attached explanation so we may correct our records if necessary.
